Sailing Center Activities

Registration for all programs remains open at [HatterasSailing.org](https://hatterassailing.org) until the program fills up or 24 hours prior to the start of the program, whichever comes first. Space in all programs is limited by the number boat(s) we use for that program and the coaches available. If the program is full, you can get on a waitlist but we cannot guarantee to open another session due to limited coaching staff. All activities meet a max 8:1 sailor to coach ratio. Head coaches are certified by US Sailing. Top Sailing Team members act as Jr. Coaches in their fleet at the coaches discretion.

- All activities are eligible for scholarship. Please do not be afraid to apply. Hatteras Community Sailing (HCS) is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization with a mission to make maritime education available to Outer Banks Residents and Visitors. Proof of residency is required for scholarships. Scholarships are awarded upon request and must be recommended by the program director and approved by the board. The board approves scholarships to sailors who show a commitment to the sport, talent, effort, a pattern of respect and merit at school or within the community. - High School Sailing is for students who will be in 8-12th grade on the date of the regatta. Rising 8th graders can practice with the team in Summer 2024 and join the team in Fall 2024. High School Sailing is interscholastic sailing. Our team competes against other school teams in our region, including GA, NC, SC. All Dare County schools are included. Homeschoolers can participate and do not have to meet requirements with Dare County. High School Sailing regattas are mandatory. Travel costs are estimated at the beginning of the season and can be included in a scholarship.

- Age based activities consider your age on June 1st, 2024. For example, to do kids sailing, children should turn 8 by June 1st, 2024. If you have a 5-7 year old who wants to participate in Optimist sailing, HCS will evaluate readiness during a private lesson. If you are 10-12 and weigh more than 110lbs you will be permitted early into the C420 Fleet.

- Activity costs do not include travel costs. Travel regattas are optional for all ages and fleets other than High School Sailing. Travel costs can be included in scholarships if approved.

- Home Regattas are mandatory for all ages and fleets. To sail in a regatta, your coach must approve you as 'ready' for each event based on the weather at the start of the event. Coach will let you know at practices leading up to the event. If you cannot sail, you are invited to be on board the race committee boat or safety boats to learn more as you prepare to participate in future regattas.



SPRING HIGH SCHOOL SAILING

We learn by doing and take a 5-Day cruise from Cape Hatteras through the Pamlico Sound to Beaufort and possibly to Oriental. One of the first tasks we do as a crew is work out our float plan together based on the current conditions. If you are interested in buying a liveaboard boat and sailing away, this is a great first step. Get a taste of the cruising life while you begin learning the key skills you need to be safe cruising without a captain or instructor.
