WINTER/SPRING REGISTRATION START DATE

Registration for the Winter/Spring programs will begin on Thursday, December 19. Swim Lesson registration will begin on Tuesday, February 25. (See Page 7)

PAVILION RESERVATIONS

Pavilion reservations for the summer of 2025 will be accepted for South Middleton Township residents only beginning Thursday, January 2. Reservations may be made in person at the South Middleton Township Building on Park Drive using cash, check or credit card or by phone at 717-258-4441 with a credit card. Beginning Monday, February 3 reservations will be accepted from non-residents for any available dates. Pavilion reservation fees are non-refundable and must be paid when making a reservation. Township residents are encouraged to make reservations in January for summer events.

South Middleton Park, located at 534 Park Drive, Boiling Springs; and Spring Meadows Park, located at 640 West First Street, Boiling Springs have pavilions available for rentals on weekends starting April 1 through October 31. Regular rental fees are \$75 per day. Add the use of the kitchen in Pavilion 5 for \$100 extra.

The Gazebo at Children's Lake Park, located at 4 East First Street, Boiling Springs is available for a daily rental fee of \$75.

REGISTER EARLY FOR PROGRAMS

Nothing stops a program in its tracks faster than everyone waiting until the last minute to register. Many of our activities need a minimum number of participants to run, so a program may be cancelled if there are not enough registrants. The minimum number of participants must be reached at least one week prior to the program beginning. Register early to prevent any unnecessary cancellations.

KAYAK POOL SESSION

LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION

#2025401 – This comprehensive lifeguard, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, First Aid and AED class will prepare you for employment as a lifeguard. **PLEASE NOTE:** These are blended learning classes. You will get a link for the online portion of the class with a deadline to complete everything. IN-water skills will be tested on the dates listed below.

Please be sure to bring a notebook and pen, swim suit and towel to every session. A personal resuscitation mask will be provided with registration.

Participants must attend all classes and successfully pass skill tests and a written exam in order to be certified. Certification is through the American Red Cross and is valid for two years.

Pre-requisites:

- Be at least 15 years old.
- Swim 150 yards using the front crawl or breaststroke, tread water for 2 min using only the legs, then swim an additional 50 yards without stopping.
- Starting in the water, swim 20 yards using front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive to 10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to surface, and swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object and exit the water without using a ladder or steps, within 1 minute 40 seconds.
