Asegúrese de que su dispositivo tenga capacidad Bluetooth. 2. Deslice el interruptor de poder para encender la unidad, indicador comenzará a parpadear. 3. Siga las instrucciones de su dispositivo para parar la unidad. 4. Parezca su dispositivo con la unidad seleccionando JAM CLÁSICO en sus listas Bluetooth en su dispositivo o seleccionando SL 5. Ensure the speaker's firmware is up-to-date by visiting the official Jam Audio website. If you're experiencing pairing issues, try moving closer to the speaker or restarting both devices to clear any connectivity problems. If you're still having trouble, follow these troubleshooting steps: \* Reset your Jam speaker by pressing and holding the power button until the indicator light flashes red. \* Unpair and re-pair your device from the Jam speaker. \* Check for interfering devices and move away if necessary. \* Contact Jam Audio support if none of the above steps resolve the issue. The Jam speaker supports three pairing modes: Single Mode, Party Mode, and Master Mode. To pair your Jam speaker, turn it on and put it in pairing mode, then enable Bluetooth on your device and search for available devices. Select the Jam speaker from the list to connect, and enter any required PIN or passkey to complete the process. Once paired, you should hear a confirmation sound from the speaker indicating successful connection.
