"A report on Medical Camp at Marballi Village, Mysuru, Karnataka"

Program conducted by JSSMC- Community Medicine department, Dentistry, Rotary Ivory-Mysuru.

The health checkup programme started at around 10:30am at health camp site in Marballi village along with Dr. Rama, Lady Medical Officer UHC, Dr. Shivaprakash, Assistant Professor in department of Anatomy JSSMC, Dr. Amoghashree, Dr. Rashmi S and Dr. Krishnaveni 1st year postgraduates in community medicine, dentistry and members of Rotary Ivory, team from UshaKiran hospital and interns from JSSMC.

General health checkup was done for people of Marballi. 246 people enrolled their names for camp out of which 137 for

General Health checkup and 109 for Dental checkup. Free drugs were dispensed. Main complaints among the adult population were related to back pain and knee pain and were treated symptomatically.

All adults were screened for hypertension and follow up was done for the known hypertensives. Patients with altered findings and poor adherence to the old treatment were referred to higher centres for further need. Complaints regarding vision and other ophthalmic complaints were screened and treated by ophthalmologist from Usha Kiran hospital. Dental problems were assessed and treated by department of community dentistry form JSS Dental College. Students of Government School of classes 1 to 4th are also underwent General Health Checkup. Rotary member Mrs Jyothi Mukesh addressed Govt High School students regarding career guidance.

Dr. Rama, Lady medical officer, UHC (JSSMC) gave talk to students of Government High School. She gave talk to girls regarding menstruation and menstrual hygiene she gave talk to boys about general hygiene and substance abuse. Under the help of Mr. Annimesh Cathurvedy, secretary, Rotary Ivory City, Mrs, Jyothi Mukesh, Community Service, Rotary Ivory City, along with 20 members of Rotary Ivory City and Mr. Shri Kumar, Gram Panchayat President, the program was successfully conducted.
