Q CAREER SERVICES



As we begin to move beyond the pandemic, we are seeing a welcomed return to student activities and campus life this year. From large-scale events that bring the community together for some fun, to our full career fairs being entirely in person, there is an excitement on campus that has been empowering to witness. With that increased activity, we

continue to see a strong labor market looking for college talent to fill needs across all industry sectors. We continue to see a strong commitment by our students to stay, work and play in Michigan. For the graduates who indicated they were employed, 99% are employed in Michigan. We saw an increase in average salaries to \$61,289 and 86% of the graduates who completed the survey indicated they participated in Experiential Learning while at OU.

Career Services moved to a more collaborative workspace model this year. Our new space creates great visibility and access to our Career Studio, where students are dropping in to get started on their career journey with a Career Ambassador. We also advanced our Career Development model, where students can begin designing the life they want to live by taking small steps to **EXPLORE**, **DISCOVER** and **CONNECT** using customized tools, programming and resources that meet them where they are on their journey.

At the State of the University Address this fall, delivered by President Ora Hirsch Pescovitz, she stated as our university becomes more of a talent pipeline, Oakland University will become a catalyst for the region's and the state's economic growth. This vision aims to establish OU as the university of choice for talent needs in the region.

Among the pillars of our success is becoming a leading university for internships and experiential learning opportunities. We feel that Career Services is an integral part of student success preparation and a place where students can explore internship and career opportunities, strengthen job search skills and build important connections for their futures.

This report shares the career outcomes of OU's 2021–22 undergraduate class and demonstrates their impact in our region and beyond by showcasing alumni success, employer recruitment testimonials and data by school and college. ABOUT THE DATA

The data presented in this report was compiled from the First-Destination Survey, which is administered annually by Oakland University Career Services. This survey captures post-graduation outcomes of Oakland University undergraduate degree recipients. The survey content, timeline and procedures align with guidelines published by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE). The survey was completed by OU students who graduated between July 01, 2021 and June 30, 2022. Results were collected through December 31st, 2022 to conform with NACE standards.

The survey was created with Handshake, a Career Services platform for Higher Education with over 1,400 institutional partners, and was distributed electronically. Summer graduates were emailed the survey in late October. Winter and Spring graduates completed the survey on the virtual commencement fair platforms. Career Services called and emailed non-respondents and those still seeking employment throughout the collection period. Finally, we queried the National Student Clearinghouse and OU student records, collected public social media profile data from LinkedIn and other platforms, and compiled records from other departments across campus for those students who indicated they were still seeking employment the last time we surveyed them.

We took care to include only high integrity data in this report. Data was inspected for duplicate responses, frequent suspicious responses (e.g., "jkla;lj" or "12345"), missing responses on more than five key questions and other validation measures. More specific details regarding data handling and interpretation are available upon request and can be directed to Oakland University Career Services.

*The First-Destination Survey is administered annually by Oakland University Career Services. The survey content, timeline, and procedures align with guidelines published by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE). The survey was administered to OU students who graduated within the fiscal year and results were collected through December 31st the following year. Results are not displayed if there are less than ten records.
